

Due to circumstances beyond our control, we were a little late opening the park this year. On Friday, May 22nd, Whispering Pines Campsites officially kicked off its 25th season.

In early November, we were hit with a major storm that caused extensive damage throughout the park., including dozens of downed trees and damaged power lines and electrical services. One camper was also damaged.

The electrical contractors began work on the repairs to the power lines in early April.

Social Distancing at Whispering Pines

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, there have been many



state mandates and Executive Orders issued by Gov. Andrew Cuomo for the state of New York.

Campgrounds have been deemed an "essential business" and have been allowed to open, but not without certain restrictions in place. We ex-

pect all of our campers to follow these guidelines. These guidelines include:

- Playgrounds, pools & social gathering rooms are closed.
- The 6' distancing must be maintained at all times between people not in the same households and masks must be worn.
- Face masks must be worn whenever you leave your site, use the restroom or visit the office. NO EX-CEPTIONS.
- Gatherings of more than
 10 people are prohibited.
- Only 2 people may use the restroom facility at any time.
